#### **Beyond the Stars: Sunita Williams's Journey**

Sunita Williams exemplifies the qualities of perseverance and determination. Her dogged persistence has opened new doors for Indian-American astronauts and space travel. Prior to her time at NASA, she served as a test pilot for the United States Navy. Setting a record for the longest spaceflight by a woman at the time, she spent 195 days in space on her maiden trip on the Space Shuttle Discovery in 2006. In addition to her many spacewalks, she completed a marathon in zero gravity.

She became one of the few women to command a space mission in 2012 when she spent an additional 127 days on the International Space Station (ISS) in the role of Commander of Expedition 33.

The Boeing Crew Flight Test, her most recent mission, took off on 5<sup>th</sup> June 2024. Technical difficulties prolonged her stay on the ISS beyond the eight days initially scheduled for her Starliner test voyage. After a successful mission aboard Starliner, she confidently returned to Earth on 18<sup>th</sup> March 2025, using SpaceX's Crew-9 capsule. She expressed her desire to "fly on it again in a heartbeat."

In addition to her accomplishments, Williams serves as an example that one's gender, background, or country should not be a hindrance to achieving one's goals. Problems are only stepping stones to success, as her story shows. Dream big, put in the time, and you will achieve your dreams!

## Student Write Up

#### **MAHAKUMBH MELA 2025**

A journey of faith, spirituality, and devotion—Maha Kumbh Mela 2025 of Prayagraj was a festival like no other. Recognised by UNESCO as an Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity, it was the world's largest religious gathering, attracting more than 400 million devotees to the Triveni Sangam, where the Ganga, Yamuna, and Saraswati rivers converge. Held every 12 years, this event was especially significant due to a rare celestial alignment that occurs only every 144 years.

According to Hindu mythology, the Kumbh Mela is associated with the story of Samudra Manthan, when Amrit fell at four different locations: Prayagraj, Haridwar, Nashik, and Ujjain. Devotees believe that taking a dip in the river during this time leads to Moksha.

This year's Maha Kumbh Mela was a spectacle of traditions and technology coming together, creating wonders. The government introduced advanced technologies, including Al-powered cameras, drones, and facial recognition systems, to enhance security and ensure smooth management. Pilgrims received RFID wristbands for tracking, and a multilingual Al chatbot assisted visitors in real-time. The festival site transformed into a 4,000-hectare temporary city, featuring 150,000 tents, 145,000 restrooms, and 3,000 kitchens with over 10,000 sanitation workers ensuring a hygienic environment. Improved transport facilities included 81 new flights connecting 17 cities to Prayagraj.

The Netra Kumbh initiative provided free eye check-ups and 300,000 spectacles to the needy, as well as captured some of the internet's unique moments—Viral girl Monalisa, IIT Baba, 'Digital Snan', and a clever entrepreneur who made ₹40,000 by selling Daatun on his girlfriend's advice. The Maha Kumbh Mela 2025 was a perfect blend of faith, tradition, and innovation, making it a remarkable experience for devotees from around the world.
